Dear Attorney General,

As a member / sympathizing of amnesty international, it is with great concern I came to understand that **Ammar al Baluchi** has been held in US detention for 15 years without a trial before a civil court. Ammar al Baluchi says he was tortured by the CIA. He was hung from the ceiling, stripped naked and exposed to loud music. His head was repeatedly banged against the wall and he was threatened over and over again in complete darkness.

He is accused of participating in the 9/11 attacks. That does not liberate the US authorities neither from their commitment to a fair trial before a civil court nor from the absolute prohibition of torture.

Please make sure to immediately bring Ammar al Baluchi before a civil court and give him a fair trial without recourse to the death penalty. Please promptly open an investigation with regard to the torture allegations that Ammar al Baluchi has raised and make sure that those responsible will be brought to court in fair trials without recourse to the death penalty.
